The petitioner has approached this Court seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus, directing the respondents to consider the claim of the petitioners for reinstating him in service.

2. The petitioner is seeking parity with other persons whose services were discharged along with the petitioner but they have been reinstated vide different orders annexed as Annexures P-2 to P-10. The petitioner also caused issuance of a Legal Notice dated 22.10.2018 (Annexure P-12) to consider his claim, but the same has not been adverted to till date.

2. Notice of motion.

3. On advance service of copy of the petition, Ms. Anu Chatrath, Senior Advocate assisted by Ms. Ambika Bedi, Assitant Advocate General,

Punjab, appears on behalf of respondents.

4. Given the nature of order being passed, there is no necessity to seek return by any of the respondents as no further proceedings and/or pleadings are required.
5. Without commenting on the merit of case, writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to objectively consider the legal notice dated 22.10.2018 (Annexure P-12) and also by keeping in view the contentions stated in this petition by treating it as a supplementary representation and pass a speaking order, in accordance with law.
6. Let the needful be done within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
7. Disposed of in above terms.
