This is second petition filed by the petitioner for grant of bail pending trial in a criminal case arising from FIR No.0016 dated 14.05.2018 registered under Section 22 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 at Police Station Mattewal, District Amritsar Rural. First bail application filed by him was withdrawn on 28.09.2018.

As per case of the prosecution, petitioner was found in conscious possession of 2110 intoxicant capsules and 2080 intoxicant tablets.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Ramesh Kumar, has submitted that the prosecution has already started recording the depositions of its witnesses.

In view thereof, there is no ground to grant concession of bail to the petitioner. However, learned trial Court is requested to make a sincere endeavour and conclude the trial expeditiously.

Disposed of, accordingly.
