Pleadings on record would indicate that a complaint had been moved by the card holders of Village Muchhal, Distribution Centre, Tarsikka against the present petitioner who happened to be the depot holder and in pursuance to which the supply of essential commodities of depot licence No.PPDS/Tarsika/47 in the name of the petitioner was suspended vide office order dated 20.09.2017 and a show cause notice had also been issued to him on 20.09.2017.

The instant writ petition was directed against the afore-noticed proceedings.

Appended alongwith the reply filed on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3 is an order dated 07.12.2017 at Annexure R11/T and a perusal of the same would reveal that after consideration of the reply filed by the petitioner to show cause notice the comments of the Assistant Food Supply Officer, Tarsika had been sought. A final decision has been taken to

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restore the supply of essential commodities pertaining to the depot licence held by the petitioner and he has been issued a warning that in future he should run the depot in accordance with the Government instructions/rules.

In the light of such positive stand taken in the written statement and in pursuance to the order at Annexure R11/T, the writ petition is rendered infructuous and is disposed of accordingly.
