The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.33 dated 28.01.2019 under Sections 394, 201, 34 IPC and Sections 25 and 29 of the Arms Act, registered at Police Station Narnaund, District Hisar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is not named in the FIR and he has been arraigned as an accused on the statement of co-accused, namely, Neeru @ Neeraj and Manish @ Nana. Co-accused have alleged that the pistol which was used in the offence was supplied by the petitioner. He, however, contends that the petitioner was thoroughly interrogated by the police but neither any pistol has been recovered nor any other recovery has been effected from him. The petitioner is 22 years old and is in custody for over five months. He further contends that the petitioner was falsely implicated in another case wherein he has been granted regular bail.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Mohinder Singh, states that 04 out of 18 prosecution witnesses have been examined.

Heard.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner especially when the petitioner is 22 years old, he is in custody for over five months, no recovery was effected from him, he has been granted regular bail in another case and conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
