ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioners are seeking regular bail in FIR No.42 dated 27.05.2019, under Sections 379-B IPC and G.D. No.025 dated 29.05.2019 under Section 22 of the NDPS Act, 1985, registered at Police Station Lakho Ke Behram, District Ferozepur.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the petitioners are not named in the FIR wherein it is alleged that two persons on a motorcycle stopped their motorcycle in front of the motorcycle of the complainant and when the complainant fell down, one of the accused had taken Rs.3500/- from the pocket of the shirt of the complainant and ran away from the spot. He also contends that it is alleged that 50 tablets of Clavidol (Tramadol), which is much below the threshold of commercial quantity, have been recovered from petitioner No.1. He also contends that the petitioners are not involved in any other case of theft, snatching or under the NDPS Act.

They are in custody for a period of over 5 months.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Kuldeep Singh, states that challan has not been filed as the report of FSL is awaited. He further contends that petitioner No.1 is involved in two other cases under Sections 323 and 420 IPC.

Heard.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioners, especially when the petitioners are in custody for over 5 months and the conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioners.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed. The petitioners are ordered to be released on regular bail on their furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
