B.S. WALIA, J (ORAL)

1. The petitioner joined as Conductor in Haryana Roadways on regular basis at Hisar Depot in the year 2008. He was transferred from Fatehabad to Hisar on 28.3.2016 and from Hisar to Faridabad on 19.10.2016. Thereafter, vide order dated 12.5.2017 (Annexure P-1), the petitioner was transferred from Faridabad to Bhiwani where he joined on 28.7.2017.

2. Challenge by the petitioner in the writ petition is to order dated 8.8.2017 (Annexure P-2) passed by respondent No.3 cancelling his transfer order dated 12.5.2017 (Annexure P-1) despite the post of Conductor lying vacant at Bhiwani where the petitioner had been posted vide order Annexure P-1.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in the absence of notice of motion having been issued and stay having been granted, the petitioner joined at Faridabad pursuant to order Annexure P-2 and that in view of new transfer policy

granted liberty to make a representation to the competent Authority in case any grievance survives and in the eventuality of any such representation being moved, the competent Authority be directed to consider and decide the same as per policy/in accordance with law.

4. In view of the statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the writ petition is disposed of as having become infructuous with the liberty as prayed for.
