ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.26 dated 20.01.2019, under Sections 307/ 34 IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959, registered at Police Station Sadar Gohana, District Sonapat.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that no injury has been attributed to the petitioner and the fire arm injury, for which Section 307 IPC has been involved, is attributed to the co-accused namely Sahil. The allegations against the petitioner are that he had caught hold of the injured. The petitioner is not named in the FIR and has been arraigned as an accused on the supplementary statement of the complainant after 5 days of the occurrence wherein it has been mentioned by Mohit that the petitioner had caught his hands while co-accused had fired a shot on him. The petitioner is in custody for over 9 months.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Naresh Kumar, states that charges have been framed and 1 out of 19 prosecution witnesses has been examined. He also states that the petitioner is involved in four other criminal cases.

Heard.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner, especially when the petitioner is not named in the FIR, he is in custody for over 9 months, no injury has been attributed to him and the conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
