The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.82 dated 11.04.2019, under Sections 305/ 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar Mansa, District Mansa.

It is apparent that the allegations in the FIR are that two months ago, son of the complainant had committed suicide as he had seen the petitioner and his mother Kulwinder Kaur (wife of the complainant) in a compromising state. It is stated in the petition that the ingredients of offence under Section 305 IPC would not be made out as it is only alleged that 2 months ago, the petitioner was seen in a compromising state with the mother of the deceased. She had left him since then and he was feeling depressed. It is also stated that there is no, *prima facie*, evidence which would connect the petitioner with the commission of the offence. The complainant had not moved any application or complaint with regard to his wife having left him or being in an illicit relationship with the petitioner. The petitioner is stated to be in custody for over 4 months.

In view of the averments in the petition and the petitioner being in custody for almost 4 months since the date of his arrest on 19.04.2019, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
