In the present writ petition, prayer of the petitioner is that service of the petitioner be regularized w.e.f. 27.01.1999/01.02.1999 in compliance to regularization policy dated 30.12.1998/25.02.1999, with all consequential benefits.

Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that the similarly situated persons, who are junior to the petitioner, have already been granted the benefit of regularization but the said benefits has not been granted to the petitioner by the competent authority without any valid reason.

Counsel for the petitioner states that for the relief, which has been sought in the present writ petition, the petitioner has served the respondents with a legal notice dated 28.12.2017 (Annexure P-17), which is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide the

Learned counsel appearing for the respondents states that he has no objection in accepting the plea of the petitioner to decide the legal notice in a time bound manner by passing a speaking order.

In view of the request made, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case or the claim being made by the petitioner, the respondents are directed to decide the legal notice dated 28.12.2017 (Annexure P-17) by passing a speaking order within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

In case, after the aforesaid decision, it is found that the petitioner is entitled for any monetary benefits, the same shall also be released to him within a period of three months thereafter.

Present writ petition stands disposed of.
