This is a petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of bail in case FIR No. 0609, dated 22.9.2017, registered under Sections 120-B, 406, 420, 467, 468, 471 IPC at Police Station Sonipat City, District Sonipat.

The allegations against petitioner are that he offered to sell plot of land allegedly owned by one Sumit to complainant and an amount of Rs. 12,00,000/- was received by him for said purpose. The petitioner had even purchased stamp papers on which agreement had been prepared. However, later on it transpired that said Sumit was non existent. Investigation in this case has been completed. The petitioner is in custody since 3.6.2019.

Without commenting anything on merit of case and also bearing in mind the fact that petitioner is in custody since 3.6.2019 and he is not wanted in any other case, no useful purpose would be served by keeping him behind bars. Hence, petition is allowed. He is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Sonipat. However, if petitioner

indulges in any activity of similar nature, for which he has been convicted, while on bail, prosecution agency will be at liberty to seek cancellation of order granting bail to petitioner.
