This common order shall dispose of **CWP No.21036 of 2019** and

CWP No.21037 of 2019 as identical questions of fact and law are involved.

The facts are being extracted from CWP No.21036 of 2019.

2. The petitioner appeared in the examination held by National Testing Agency for admission to Engineering Colleges and was successful. She applied online and was allocated a seat in Punjab Engineering College, Chandigarh. She was required to report on 4/5-07-2019 at the reporting centre for certificates' verification. Accordingly, the petitioner reported on 04.07.2019 and was allocated a seat in the Civil Engineering in the Bachelor of Technology course. Acceptance fee of Rs.35,000/- was deposited on the same date. Thereafter, the petitioner appeared for orientation on 29.07.2019 when she was informed that a sum of Rs.51,000/- was required to be deposited between 19.07.2019 to 23.07.2019 and the same having not been deposited, her admission had been cancelled.

3. While issuing notice of motion vide order dated 31.07.2019, interim directions was given to reserve one seat for the petitioner.

4. Keeping in view the interim directions, one seat has remained vacant in the discipline of Civil Engineering. Last date for admission is over, thus, we deem it appropriate to direct the respondents to admit the petitioner against the said vacant seat.

5. In the case of the petitioner in CWP No.21037 of 2019, seat was reserved in the discipline of Electronics and Communication in the Scheduled Caste category as the petitioner had been admitted against the said seat. Thus, the petitioner in this case shall be admitted in the discipline of Electronics and Communication.

6. Both the Writ Petitions are accordingly, disposed of.
