The present petition has been filed by petitioner-Karamjeet Singh praying for a writ of mandamus for directing the respondents to consider and appoint the petitioner as Assistant Lineman in SC (Ex. Servicemen Category) in the Punjab State Transmission Corporation Limited.

On the last date of hearing i.e. 08.11.2019, the Chief Engineer/HIS&D of the respondent-Corporation was directed to be personally present on the next date of hearing to apprise the Court with regard to the status of the on going recruitment process.

Learned counsel for the respondents, on instructions from Sh. Inder Jeet Singh, Chief Engineer, HIS&D, who is present in Court, submits that the recruitment process was finalized on 03.07.2018. All the posts of

Ex. Servicemen as per rules have been filled.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner fairly makes a statement that in fact the petitioner has since joined some other organization, he is not interested in pursuing the matter any further.

In this view of the matter, the writ petition is disposed of as having become infructuous as it requires no further orders.
