By this petition, filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C., the petitioner seeks the concession of 'regular bail'.

Learned State counsel on instructions from the police official who is present in Court to assist him, submits that upon a disclosure statement having been made by the petitioner, another co-accused was arrested, from whom 54 kilograms of puppy husk and 1080 tablets of alprasafe/alprazolam were recovered. Very obviously, even as per the FIR as regards the recovery against the petitioner himself, he was found to be in possession of 600 grams of opium (as per the case of the investigating agency), with the commercial quantity being above 2.5 k.g.

Upon query to the learned State counsel, he submits on instructions that there is no other criminal case registered against the petitioner.

That being so, I deem it appropriate to admit the petitioner to bail during the pendency of the trial.

Consequently, without making any comment on the actual merit of the case, for or against the petitioner, this petition is allowed. The petitioner would be enlarged on bail, upon his furnishing adequate bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
