The crushing season of sugarcane for 2016-17 is over, rendering the petition infructuous. The respondents have an explanation why the request of the farmers for assignment of their crops to the Haryana Cooperative Sugar Mills Ltd., Rohtak was shifted to Ch. Devi Lal Cooperative Sugar Mills Limited, Gohana, which latter village in which the Mills are located is in close proximity of the other Mill and is not more than 10 Kms distant by road. Therefore, no longer does the cause of action subsist. The Court is informed that crops are assigned millwise according to the request of the farmers in terms of Rule 10(1) of the Haryana Sugarcane (Regulation of Purchase and Supply) Rules, 1992.

Accordingly, this petition is dismissed as infructuous.
