The present appeal directs challenge against award dated 01.09.2011 passed by the Motor Accidents Claims Tribunal, Rewari whereby application for grant of compensation was dismissed with costs.

The appellants failed to deposit publication charges despite last opportunity granted for the purpose vide order dated 26.02.2019.

Counsel for the appellants would state that the appellants have expressed their inability to deposit the publication charges. That being so, appeal against respondent No.2 is liable to be dismissed and ordered accordingly.

As the appeal against respondent No.2, registered owner of the vehicle has been dismissed, the appellants cannot press for disposal of the appeal on merits against an order dismissing their application for grant of compensation. As such, the appeal is liable to be dismissed and ordered accordingly.

Disposed of accordingly.
