HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI, J.

Counsel for the petitioners claims that all the benefits, for the services, which the petitioners have rendered with Khalsa College, Amritsar have not been granted to them and the prayer of the petitioners is that a direction be issued to Khalsa College, Managing Committee, Amritsar for releasing all the pensionary benefits of the petitioners along with interest.

No one has appeared on behalf of respondent No.3 so far.

Counsel for respondent No.4 states that the dispute is between the petitioners and the Managing Committee of Khalsa College and keeping in view the settled principle of law settled by this Court in CWP No.25942 of 2012 titled as **Suresh Sharma vs. State of Punjab and others** decided on 11.04.2019, all the disputes between employee and the Managing Committee are to be adjudicated before the Educational Tribunal at the first instance. The said order has already been upheld by the Division Bench of this Court while

deciding LPA No.892 of 2019 titled as Surinder Krishan Sharma vs. State of Punjab and others on 09.05.2019.

Faced with this situation, counsel for the petitioners prays that he be allowed to withdraw the present petition with liberty to approach the Educational Tribunal for redressal of the grievance of the petitioners as being raised in the present writ petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty as prayed for
