B.S. WALIA, J (ORAL)

1. The petitioner joined as Driver in Haryana Roadways on regular basis in the year 2008 at Chandigarh Depot and was transferred from Hisar to Faridabad vide order dated 5.9.2016 (Annexure P-1). On 12.6.2017, the petitioner was transferred from Faridabad to Hisar where he joined on 13.6.2017. Thereafter vide order dated 11.8.2017 (Annexure P-3), the petitioner was relieved for Faridabad depot where he joined.

2. Challenge in the writ petition is to order dated 11.8.2017 (Annexure P-3) passed by respondent No.3 vide which the petitioner has been transferred from Hisar to Faridabad on the ground that the same is against Government Policy dated 6.10.2004 (Annexure P-4).

3. Although the writ petition was filed on 10.10.2017 yet notice of motion has not been issued.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to order Annexure P-3, the petitioner joined at Faridabad and that in the circumstances, the writ petition has become infructuous and may be disposed of as such with liberty to make a representation in case any grievance survives and in the eventuality of any such representation being moved, the competent Authority be directed to consider and decide the same in accordance with law.

5. In view of the statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the writ petition is disposed of as having become infructuous with the liberty as prayed for.
