ARUN MONGA, J. (ORAL)

1. The petitioner herein is seeking extension in his service on attaining the age of 58 years until the age of 60 years, as per the provisions of Person with Disability (Equal Opportunities, Protection of Rights and Full Participation) Act, 1995 (herein after referred to as "the Act"), as he is 40% disabled.

2. Learned counsel for the respondents at the very outset submits that extension has been granted to the petitioner during the pendency of writ petition and therefore, the petition has become infructuous.

3. In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the respondents, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to give all the consequential benefits which the petitioner may be entitled to on grant of extension in service after attaining the age of 58 years until the age of 60 years in accordance with the Actz *ibid*.
