On joint request made by counsel for the parties, the application is taken up for hearing and disposal.

Counsel for the non-applicant/respondent has got no objection.

In view of averments made in the application supported by an affidavit of Rashim Sharma daughter of late Sh. Ashwani Sharma, appellant – Vijay Laxmi (since deceased) has left no legal heir except Rashim Sharma.

In view of the aforesaid, the application is allowed and Rashim Sharma is ordered to be impleaded as LR of appellant-Vijay Laxmi for the purpose of present lis, subject to just exceptions.

Amended memo of parties is taken on record.

Disposed of accordingly.

Original Special Power of Attorney purported to be executed by Rashim Sharma in favour of Faljeet Singh, filed in the Court is taken on record.

Counsel for the applicant/respondent would state that dispute between legal heir of appellant Vijay Laxmi and applicant/respondent Narinder Pal Singh has been settled by way of compromise (Annexed with CM No.16311-C of 2019 in RSA No.279 of 2004). In view thereof, the appeal may be dismissed having rendered infructuous.

Counsel for the non-applicant/respondent concedes to this fact.

On joint request made by counsel for the parties, RSA No.1521 of 2009 is taken on board and is dismissed having rendered infructuous in view of compromise Annexure C/1, original whereof is appended with CM No.16311-C of 2019 in RSA No.279 of 2004.
