Petitioner has challenged the order dated 20.12.2018, whereby his application for grant of parole for getting his minor daughter admitted in a school has been dismissed.

Having heard Mr. Jindal and keeping in view the fact that admissions to the academic session 2019-20 are closed in October and it is very difficult for any institution/school to entertain admission request of petitioner's daughter at this belated stage, I do not find any ground to release the petitioner for the purpose. It is not the case that the petitioner has an offer of admission and his presence is required to complete the formalities.

Consequently, the petition stands dismissed.
