In the present writ petition, the claim which is being made by the petitioner is that the petitioner has not been given the retiral benefits after he attained the age of superannuation on 30.09.2016. The claim for the release of the salary for the period from March, 2016 till September, 2016 has also been made.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that for the relief which has been claimed in the present writ petition, the petitioner has served the respondents with a legal notice dated 15.04.2017 (Annexure P-3) and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide the legal notice dated 15.04.2017 (Annexure P-3) including the claim of the petitioner for the grant of interest by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Learned counsel for the respondents has no objection for the grant of the prayer as being claimed by the petitioner.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case or about the entitlement of the petitioner for the relief which has been claimed by her in

the legal notice dated 15.04.2017 (Annexure P-3) including the claim of the petitioner for the grant of interest, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to decide the legal notice dated 15.04.2017 (Annexure P-3) including the claim of the petitioner for the grant of interest within a period of three months from the receipt of copy of this order.

In case, it is found that the petitioner is entitled for any monetary benefits after the decision of the legal notice, the same should also be paid to her within three months thereafter.
