DEEPAK SIBAL, J. (ORAL)

Learned counsel for the appellant submits that through the present appeal the appellant/claimant does not seek any enhancement in the awarded compensation. His only grievance is with regard to exoneration of respondent No.3-Insurance Company from payment of awarded compensation and imposition of the same only on the owner of the offending vehicle.

Once the appellant does not claim any enhancement in the awarded compensation, he does not have any cause to approach this Court against exoneration of respondent No. 3-Insurance Company from payment of the awarded compensation and has the right to get the award passed by the Motor Accident Claims Tribunal, Fatehabad executed against the owner of the offending vehicle in accordance with law.
