The challenge in this writ petition is to the order dated 23.7.2018 (Annexure P3) passed by the Appellate Tribunal-cum-Deputy Commissioner, Jind on an appeal under Section 22 of the Maintenance and Welfare of Parents and Senior Citizens Act, 2007.
