The present contempt petition has been filed alleging wilful disobedience of the order dated 30.01.2019 passed by this Court in CWP No. 10245 of 2018. The operative part of the order is reproduced below:

“In view of the above, the present writ petitions are disposed of with the directions to the respondents to decide the representations/legal notice(s) as the case may be by passing appropriate speaking orders within the period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order. In case after passing the order, it is found that the petitioners are entitled for interest as per the settled principles of law, the same should be calculated @ 9% per annum and the same shall be given to the petitioners within a period of three months thereafter.”

Learned State counsel has produced a copy of the order dated 27.05.2019 alongwith pay order. In the order, details of calculation is given

and the petitioner is found entitled to interest of Rs. 1,29,264/-.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in view of the order dated 27.05.2019, no cause of action survives for pursuing the contempt petition. However, he seeks liberty to avail remedies in accordance with law, if aggrieved from the calculation of interest.

Disposed of with liberty as prayed for.

Rule issued against the respondents is discharged.
