The petitioners are seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.8 dated 26.01.2019, under Sections 341, 326, 323, 324, 148, 149 IPC (offence under Section 326 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Bhaini Mian Khan, District Gurdaspur.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that it is a case of version and cross version. After the election for the post of Sarpanch, there was an altercation between the parties. Both the parties sustained injuries. He further contends that the matter has now been compromised and a petition for quashing is being filed.

This Court, by the order dated 30.08.2019, had directed the petitioners to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of their arrest, they were ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Mohan Lal, states that the petitioners have joined investigation and are not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioners and the petitioners having joined investigation, the order dated 30.08.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioners shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. They shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
