The proposal for delimitation of Parliamentary and Assembly Constituencies in the State of Haryana was published vide order dated 30.10.2006. The petitioner had made a representation. However, the fact of the matter is that final decision was taken by the Delimitation Commission on 15.2.2007.

The Assembly Elections in the State of Haryana have already been notified. It is settled law that once the election process has commenced, the same cannot be stopped. The petitioner is now estopped from challenging the delimitation at a belated stage after the lapse of almost 12 years. Accordingly, there is no merit in the present writ petition. The same is dismissed.
