B.S. WALIA, J (ORAL)

1. The petitioner joined as Conductor in Haryana Roadways on regular basis in the year 2008 and vide order dated 5.5.2016 (Annexure P-1) was transferred from Jind to Charkhi Dadri from where he was transferred to Jind on 12.5.2017 and pursuant thereto, the petitioner joined at Jind on 15.6.2017. However, vide order dated 28.9.2017 (Annexure P-3) the petitioner was relieved for Charkhi Dadri Depot where the petitioner joined duty in compliance of order Annexure P-3.

2. Challenge in the writ petition is to order dated 28.9.2017 (Annexure P-3) passed by respondent No.3 vide which the petitioner has been transferred from Jind to Charkhi Dadri on the ground that the same is against Government Policy dated 6.10.2004 (Annexure P-4).

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in the absence of notice of motion having been issued besides the impugned order having been acted upon,

the writ petition has become infructuous and the same be disposed of as such

with liberty to make a representation in case any grievance survives and in the eventuality of any such representation being moved, the competent Authority be directed to consider and decide the same in accordance with law.

5. In view of the statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the writ petition is disposed of as having become infructuous with the liberty as prayed for.
