The present writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ of mandamus for directing the respondents to issue the appointment order to the petitioners for the post of Science Masters/Mistress.

In the written statement filed on behalf of respondent Nos. 1 to 3, it has been averred that the names of the petitioners have been considered for the post of Science Masters/Mistress.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have been appointed as Science Masters/Mistress. However, the notional pay fixation and the seniority have not been granted to them.

In view of the above, this petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2- Director Public Instructions (SE), Punjab, B-Block, 4th Floor, PSEB Building, Phase VIII, Mohali to consider the case of the petitioners for notional pay fixation and the seniority as per merit in case a representation in this regard is made by the petitioners within three months from the receipt of certified copy of this order.

The needful be done within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. In case, on consideration, the competent authority reaches to the conclusion that the benefit claimed by the petitioners is admissible to them, in such eventuality, the consequential relief be allowed to them, within a period of six weeks thereafter. However, in case the competent authority feels that the relief claimed by the petitioners is not admissible or made out, in that case, a speaking order be passed in the matter.
