[1] Civil Writ Petition has been filed, seeking the issuance of a Writ of Certiorari for quashing the action of respondent No.2 in not considering the petitioner eligible for exemption from passing HTET/STET test as granted to candidates who had experience as teacher of a minimum period of 04 years in Privately Managed Government Aided Schools/Recognized Schools/Government Schools etc. till 11.04.2012.

[2] Learned Deputy Advocate General, Haryana, states that the challenge is misconceived for after having participated in the written test the petitioner did not participate in the second stage of selection process i.e. interview and in view thereof, the present Writ Petition is not maintainable.

[3] Faced with the aforementioned situation, learned Senior Counsel assisted by Ms. Daljit Kaur, Advocate, states that in the circumstances, she

does not press the Writ Petition.
