Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 55, dated 17.7.2019, registered under Section 61 (1) of Excise Act, 2014, at P.S. Balachaur, District SBS Nagar.

The allegations in the FIR are that huge quantity of liquor, meant for sale in Chandigarh only, was recovered from the bushes. He was named by Krishan Dev, who suffered statement before police that petitioner is same person, who kept concealed the liquor, meant for sale in Chandigarh only.

The learned counsel for petitioner states that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the case.

Vide order dated 30.9.2019, this Court, while granting the concession of interim anticipatory bail, directed the petitioner to join the investigation.

The learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Joginder Singh, states that the petitioner has joined the investigation.

In view of above, petition is allowed. The order dated 30.9.2019, granting interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner, is

made absolute. However, the petitioner shall join investigation as and when called upon to do so by the Investigating Agency and shall abide by conditions of Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
