This writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been filed for the issuance of a writ of Mandamus directing the respondents to register the marriage of the petitioners and issue them the necessary certificate.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that at this stage he would be satisfied, if a direction is issued to respondent No.2-Registrar-cum-Tehsildar, Marriages, Jagraon District Ludhiana, to consider and decide the representation dated 16.08.2018 (Annexure P-4).

Heard.

A complete set of paper book has been handed over to learned State counsel, in the Court today.

In view of the above, without advertng to the merits of the

case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to consider and decide the representation dated 16.08.2018 (Annexure P-4) within six weeks from the receipt of the certified copy of the judgment after giving an effective opportunity of hearing to the petitioners. In case, on consideration, the competent authority reaches to the conclusion that the benefit claimed by the petitioners is admissible to them, in such eventuality, the consequential relief be allowed to them, within a period of six weeks thereafter. However, in case the competent authority feels that the relief claimed by the petitioners is not admissible or made out, in that case, a speaking order be passed in the matter.
