Petitioner has prayed for a writ in the nature of mandamus to direct the respondents to issue an appointment letter to petitioner No.1 in view of the fact that his deceased father was injured in anti terrorist drive. An affidavit dated 16.11.2018 of Suresh Arora, Director General of Police, has been filed. Referring to same, State counsel submits that only entitlement of the petitioner would be to compete against 2% quota meant for wards of police personnel. No other benefit can be granted to the petitioner No.1. Admittedly, his mother (petitioner No.2 herein) has already been appointed on compassionate ground.

This court finds substance in the plea of the State. In view of the fact petitioner No.1 is entitled to compete against 2% quota, no other direction can be given. Petition is, thus, disposed of.
