Petitioner is stated to be aged 26 years. She was married to respondent no.4 in the year 2015 and out of the wedlock a male child was born in the year 2016.

As per averments made in the petition the matrimonial alliance between the parties has run into rough weather and the petitioner having been left with no choice is now residing in Kharar, District S.A.S. Nagar and is doing a private job.

Instant writ petition seeks a Mandamus for issuance of directions to the official respondents to protect her life and liberty by voicing an apprehension and threat to the same at the hands of private respondent no.4. In the writ petition there are certain averments as regards respondent no.4 continuously harassing the petitioner and insisting upon her to return into the matrimonial home. Against such backdrop petitioner fears for her life.

Without even ascertaining the correctness of the averments made in the petition, I deem it appropriate to dispose of the same in terms of granting liberty to the petitioner to approach respondent no.3 confined to the aspect of danger and threat to her life.

In the eventuality of any such application being preferred, respondent no.3 would be obligated to look into the same and to thereafter take steps as he may deem fit and warranted in accordance with law.
