Instant writ petition was filed seeking a mandamus for directing the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners by voicing an apprehension and threat to the same at the hands of private respondents No.4 to 8.

It was averred that the petitioners have entered into matrimony against the wishes of their elders and in such situation they fear for their life.

An advance copy of the writ petition already stood served upon the State of Haryana.

Mr. Siddharth Sanwaria, learned DAG, Haryana has filed in Court today a response by way of a short affidavit dated 08.09.2019 of the Deputy Superintendent of Police, Shahabad Markanda, Kurukshetra along with Annexures R-1 to R-7. The same is taken on record.

Perusal of the affidavit as also the appended annexures would make it clear that statements of the parties have since been recorded and the matrimonial alliance between the petitioners has since been accepted by the

family members and now the petitioners do not apprehend any danger and threat to their life and liberty.

In view of the above, no directions are required to be passed in the instant writ petition and the same is disposed of as rendered infructuous.
