The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.0050 dated 24.04.2019, registered under Sections 379, 447, 511, 34 IPC at Police Station Sadar Bathinda, District Bathinda.

The operative part of the order dated 07.08.2019, vide which interim anticipatory bail has been granted to the petitioner, is reproduced as under:-

“...The petitioner has relied upon the order dated 3.7.2019 passed in CRM-M-23471-2019, vide which the anticipatory bail of co-accused Manpreet Singh was confirmed. A perusal of this order further shows that the petitioner in the said petition i.e. co-accused Manpreet has given an undertaking to deposit an amount of Rs.One lac with the trial Court.

Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that, in pursuance to the order dated 07.08.2019, the petitioner has appeared before the

Investigating Officer and has joined the investigation. It is further submitted that the petitioner has also deposited the amount of Rs.1 lac in terms of the order dated 07.08.2019.

Counsel for the State, on instructions from HC Gurdeep Singh, has not disputed the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 07.08.2019 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
