RAJIV NARAIN RAINA, J. (Oral)

1. This order will dispose of the above-mentioned two cases as common question is involved in them, which can conveniently be decided by a common order.

2. The petitioners were pursuing their LLB Course in MDU, Rohtak prior to their appointment in the establishment of the Sessions Division, Jhajjar. They requested permission to continue with the degree course in the evening session. The request was rejected by the learned District and Sessions Judge, Jhajjar by order dated 05.05.2018. Aggrieved by the rejection of their request, the petitioners have

approached this Court seeking a direction to permit them to continue pursuing their course in the evening shift. Maharishi Dayanand University, Rohtak is made party and a direction is sought to the University to shift the petitioners from morning to evening session permitting them to continue the LLB degree programme. The decision of the Bar Council of India dated 30.11.2016 has been placed on record by the University at Annex. R-3/1 wherein holding grant of affiliation of running evening classes beyond 14th June, 2016 will be in violation of statutory rules. Meaning thereby that evening classes have been discontinued. Hence, granting affiliation for evening classes was not allowed. The letter has been addressed to the Registrar, Maharishi Dayanand University, Rohtak.

3. In view of dis-continuation of evening classes, no relief can be given to the petitioners as in the morning they are duty bound to serve in the Sessions Division and in the evening there are no longer any classes held.

4. Accordingly, the petitions have no life and are dismissed.
