1. Learned DAG by referring to paragraph No.3 of the preliminary submission of the written statement filed on behalf of respondent Nos.2 and 3 contends that the grievance of the petitioners has been redressed and in view thereof, the writ petition has become infructuous.

2. A perusal of paragraph No.3 of the preliminary submissions reveals that the department vide letter No.5580/EA-1/2018 dated 04.04.2018, directed the District Social Welfare Officer, Hisar i.e. the Controlling Officer of the petitioner to get the GPF account number allotted from the Accountant General, Haryana and further to take action to deposit the contribution of the petitioner lying in his new pension account maintained by the Fund Manager i.e. NSDL and to credit the same to the GPF account of the petitioner so allotted to him by the Accountant General and simultaneously credit the share of the government under head 0071-pension and other retiral benefits by contacting

the Treasury Officer concerned.

3. The same satisfies the learned counsel for the petitioner.
4. In view of the position as noted above, the writ petition is disposed
of as having become infructuous.
