Petitioner seeks a Mandamus for directing the respondent-Indian Oil Corporation Ltd. to issue in her favour a Letter of Intent for commissioning of L.P.G Distributorship at Surajpur, District Panchkula.

Learned senior counsel has been heard at length.

Mr. Ashish Kapoor, Advocate has entered appearance on behalf of the respondent-Corporation and submits that pursuant to the name of the petitioner having been entered in the Draw of Lots and she having been declared successful, subsequent process of field verification is still under way.

Apparently the instant petition is directed against a show cause notice having been issued to the petitioner whereby one particular deficiency has been pointed out.

Since no final order with regard to the claim of the petitioner has been passed by the respondent-Corporation as of date no intervention is warranted at this stage.

It would be open for the petitioner to pursue her claim with the respondent-Corporation and which would be dealt with in terms of passing a final order.

It is, however, made clear that this Court has not examined the issue on merits.
