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**B.S. WALIA, J. (ORAL)**

[1] On 04.09.2019, learned counsel for respondent Nos.4 and 5 stated that fresh seniority list had been framed for Drivers (Ministers Car Section) in which the respondents had been placed senior to the petitioner and that in the circumstances, the writ petition had become infructuous.

[2] Today, learned counsel for respondent Nos.4 and 5 states that the fresh seniority list as framed for Drivers (Ministers Car Section) was challenged by some other candidates by way of CWP No.14482 of 2018 and the said writ petition has been allowed but the detailed judgment is yet to be released.

[3] Faced with the aforementioned situation, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for permission to withdraw the writ petition with liberty to take out appropriate proceedings in accordance with law.

[4] In view of the statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the writ petition is dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty as prayed for.
