ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.114, dated 15.05.2019, under Sections 307, 148 and 149 IPC, registered at Police Station Beas, District Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations against the petitioner are that he had given a 'datar' blow on the arm of the injured Mangal Singh. This injury was found to be simple in nature. He also contends that the main accused Yuvraj Singh had caused injuries on the head of Mangal Singh.

This Court, by the order dated 01.10.2019, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Sukhwant Singh, states that the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the submissions of the learned counsel for the petitioner and the petitioner having joined investigation, the order dated 01.10.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
