Petitioners seek a writ of mandamus for issuance of directions to the official respondents to protect their life and liberty by voicing an apprehension and threat to the same at the hands of private respondents.

Case projected on behalf of the petitioners was that they have entered into matrimony against the wishes of their elders/parents and under such circumstances they apprehend for their life.

Learned State counsel upon instructions from ASI Joginder Singh has apprised the Court that the statement of petitioner No.1 has since been recorded and as per which private respondents have accepted the marriage between the parties and as such she does not now apprehend any threat to her life as also of her husband namely Manpreet Singh.

To the same effect is the statement made by counsel for the petitioners.

In view of the above no further directions are required to be passed.

Petition is disposed of as infructuous.
