Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for quashing of order dated 01.07.2014 passed by learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Panipat, whereby the petitioner was declared as a proclaimed person in the case bearing FIR No.244 dated 02.04.2013 under Sections 363, 366-A, 343, 506 and 120-B IPC and Section 12 of the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012.

On 28.08.2019, this Court, while issuing notice of motion for today, had ordered that in case the petitioner surrenders before the trial Court within a week from that date, he shall be admitted on interim bail subject to furnishing of his appropriate bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

No one has put in appearance on behalf of the petitioner.

Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of at this stage with a direction that in case the petitioner has complied the order dated 28.08.2019 passed by this Court and has been admitted on bail by the trial Court, the order dated 28.08.2019 passed by this Court would be considered as absolute and the petitioner shall continue to appear before the trial Court regularly unless exempted by the Court below and shall face the trial in accordance with law.

It is made clear that in case of non-compliance of the order dated 28.08.2019 by the petitioner, the present petition shall be deemed to have been dismissed.
