Petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure has been filed for quashing of complaint bearing No.COMA-8539/2017 dated 19.07.2017 along with summoning order and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has pointed out that 13 such complaints were filed against the petitioner. He had filed CRM-M-31434-2019, which has been disposed of by this Court vide order dated 17.08.2019. The order passed by Coordinate Bench is extracted as under:-

“Present petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for quashing of Complaint No.COMA-8715/2017 dated 24.07.2017 (P-1); summoning order dated 25.07.2017 (P-2) and order dated 30.08.2018 (P-3) along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom.

After arguing for sometime, learned Counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the present petition with a limited prayer that petitioner be granted sufficient opportunities to lead his evidence as learned trial Court is proceeding with the matter in a very hasty manner.

Without commenting upon the latter part of the submission, made above, this petition is dismissed as withdrawn, however, learned trial Court will ensure that petitioner be afforded three effective opportunities to conclude his entire defence evidence after 19.08.2019, the date already fixed before learned trial Court.

Needless to say that petitioner would be at liberty to take all his pleas available under law while leading his defence evidence.

Ordered accordingly.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that he will be satisfied if the present petition is disposed of, in terms of above-said order dated 17.08.2019.

Without commenting on the merits and keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case, the present petition is disposed of, in the same terms as in CRM-M-31434-2019.
