Learned counsel for the respondents states that a decision has already been taken by the respondent-MARKFED to release the benefits, for which the petitioner is entitled, as no proceedings have been found pending against the petitioner at this stage. However, the said release will be subject to the condition that MARKFED, if found entitled at any given point of time, will recover the said amount after following due procedure of law. Learned counsel for the respondents states that benefits will be released within a period of two months from now.

Keeping in view the statement made by learned counsel for the respondents-MARKFED, learned counsel for the petitioner states that petitioner claims interest on the delayed payment and she be given liberty to agitate the same before the respondents.

Liberty is granted to the petitioner to approach the respondents, in case, he wants interest on the payments, which are being released now.

In view of the above, writ petition is disposed of.
