This is the second petition filed by the petitioner under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in FIR No.115 dated 31.03.2018 under Sections 346, 363 and 366-A IPC, Sections 4, 6 and 18 of the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012 and Section 3 of the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 and Amended Act 2015 registered at Police Station Sadar Fatehabad, District Fatehabad.

The earlier petition filed by the petitioner i.e. ***CRM-M-171 of 2019*** was dismissed as withdrawn vide order dated May 13, 2019 passed by this Court.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Jug Lal, states that the trial in the case is at quite advance stage as all the prosecution

witnesses except one, have already been examined in the case and the case is fixed for examination of that witness before the trial Court today itself.

Considering the fact that the case is fixed before the trial Court at an advance stage, this Court finds that no ground is made out for grant of regular bail to the petitioner particularly when the earlier petition filed by him i.e. **CRM-M-171 of 2019** has already been dismissed by this Court vide order dated May 13, 2019.

The present petition is, accordingly, dismissed.
