Learned counsel for the petitioner states that though interest as awarded by this Court on 7.3.2019 in CWP No. 215 of 2018 has been paid, albeit there is dispute with regard to calculation of interest. He states that detailed calculation with representation would be filed within one week from today.

Learned counsel for the State submits that in case such representation is filed, the same would be decided within three months after providing opportunity of hearing to the petitioner. She further states that in case something is found due, the same would be paid to the petitioner within four weeks thereafter.

In view of the above, the contempt petition is disposed of as infructuous.
