ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.143 dated 03.11.2017, under Sections 307, 326, 325, 324, 323, 148 and 149 IPC, registered at Police Station Mahilpur, District Hoshiarpur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the injury which is attributed to the petitioner is on the elbow of the left arm of injured Jatinder Kumar which was found to be grievous in nature but Jatinder Kumar has fully recovered from that injury. He further states that the injury, for which Section 307 IPC has been invoked, is attributed to the co-accused Mandeep Kumar @ Manny. He also states that the petitioner is in custody from the date of his arrest on 25.10.2018. He is not involved in any other case. He also contends that the co-accused Mohd. Hanif and Pardeep Kumar @ Sunny had been granted regular bail in CRM-M-49253-2018 and CRM-M-9533-2018 on 12.04.2019. He also contends that 4 out of 23 witnesses have been examined.

Heard.

In view of the submissions of the learned counsel for the petitioner, especially when the petitioner is in custody for over 11 months, the co-accused had been granted bail and the conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
