Present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case bearing FIR No.207 dated 26.07.2019, under Sections 186, 353, 427 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 (*for short 'IPC'*) (Section 506, IPC added later on), registered at Police Station City Dadri, District Charkhi Dadri.

This Court, on the previous date of hearing i.e. 09.08.2019, passed the following order:-

“ It transpires that petitioner has moved some applications for seeking information under the R.T.I. Act and the present FIR is counter-blast to the same.

Notice of motion for 23.09.2019.

In the meanwhile, the petitioner is directed to join the investigation before the Investigating Officer. In the event of his arrest, the Arresting Officer would admit him to interim bail in the present case till the next date of hearing on his furnishing adequate bail and surety bonds to his satisfaction. The petitioner is also directed to abide by all the conditions as

envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. ”

 Contents that in terms of above order, petitioner has joined the investigation.

 Learned State Counsel, on instructions from ASI Vikram, has acknowledged that in terms of order dated 09.08.2019, petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required.

 In view of above, interim order dated 09.08.2019 is made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

 It is also made clear that petitioner shall fully co-operate with the Investigating Officer as and when called for further investigation.

 Disposed off accordingly.
