Learned State counsel submits that result of the petitioner, which was kept in a sealed cover has been opened and the same reveals that she has obtained a total of 153 marks by adding her performance in the written examination and the interview.

He submits that even if the petitioner is given the benefit of age relaxation as contended by her, she still does not make it on merits as marks obtained by the last selected candidate are more than her i.e. 174.80.

In the premise, no further interference is called for.
