The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in complaint case No.COMI-13/2014 dated 17.12.2013 (present case No.SC/445/2018 after committal) under Sections 147, 149, 217, 218, 323, 325, 326, 427, 452, 307 and 506 read with Section 149 IPC.

The petitioner, who is present in Court, states that the allegations against him in the complaint are that while he was investigating officer, he had tried to favour some of the accused and had not presented challan against them. The trial Court had earlier been granted him bail but he could not appear on 12.07.2019, therefore, his bail bonds were cancelled. He submits that he was unwell on that day and has referred to the copy of medical certificate which is appended as Annexure P-4. He undertakes that he shall appear before the trial Court on each and every date of hearing and shall not absent himself without prior permission of this Court.

This Court, by the order dated 08.08.2019, had directed the petitioner to appear before the trial Court and on his doing so, he was to be released on ad-interim bail on his furnishing bonds to its satisfaction.

Learned State counsel states that the petitioner had appeared before the trial Court and submitted his bonds.

In view of the above, interim order dated 08.08.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall appear before the trial Court on each and every date and shall not absent himself without the prior permission of the trial Court.

The petition stands disposed of.
